"Put one foot in front of the other and lead with Love!"


Secretary's Report

WHAT A BLESSING this opportunity was! God held me through it all, and I only stumbled slightly when speaking – when my mind would race ahead of my tongue, yet, when I looked back at the recording, it wasn't as noticeable as I was afraid it had been. Most people probably wouldn't have noticed my slight "halt" in speech as much as I since I knew where it was and what I had meant to say at that moment.


Just as God has placed me in several situations that have been out of my comfort zone, He is looking to use you somewhere, even it is "outside of your comfort zone." Just as He provided all Moses needed to go before the Pharoah, we need to remember that God can give you all you need to do whatever He is calling you to do on His behalf. He will never send you into a situation and set you up for failure, but will show you that, through all things, He is faithful to see you through whatever He wants you to do in His name.

We must remember that Moses was no spring chicken when he was called to bring God's people out of Egypt. Abraham also was a man "seasoned" with age when he was called to travel to the promised land with his wife to become a nation of peoples numbered greater than the stars. God can even use YOU – no matter your age – to further His work and His kingdom on this earth. Just remember to keep an open mind to what God is calling you to do – whether it is to serve in an office of United Women in Faith or to be present for someone who needs your love and support during a difficult time in their lives.
