



4. You will see the various categories of resources: Educate, Organize, Lead, Grow, Serve & Advocate, and Merchandise. By hovering over each of the down arrows to the left of the category names, a sub category of resources in each category will appear. The image above shows the categories for "Educate."

5. From there, just explore each category and sub-category looking for the resource you are seeking. It can take a few attempts.

6. The 2025 Program Resource is under the category: Educate, sub-category: Program Resource.

7. Under "Organize" is a subcategory: "Call to Prayer, World Thank, Offering." Envelopes are available in that page. https://uwfaithresources.org/prodDetail.cfm?productID=9757&catid=2186


