

Last year, Cunningham CIRCLE Academy-Vermilion's Rad Runners, a group of enthusiastic students and staff, not only met their physical goals in the Be a Hero 5K but also built a supportive community with their peers [read last year's story here]. As you see with Devin's and Jamison's comments above, this enthusiasm has now spread across multiple programs at Cunningham Children's Home, uniting youth in their pursuit of health, community and personal achievement.
